CONSUMERS/PROTECTION. Requests the Louisiana Public Service Commission to promulgate rules and regulations to protect consumers whose water or gas service ran unabated in an area declared to be a state of disaster or emergency.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the Louisiana Public Service Commission to promulgate rules and 3 regulations to protect consumers whose gas service ran unabated in an area declared 4 by the governor as a state of emergency or disaster. 5 WHEREAS, the citizens of the state of Louisiana have suffered greatly as a result 6 of the damage inflicted by hurricanes Katrina and Rita; and 7 WHEREAS, countless citizens across this state experienced complete destruction of 8 their homes and businesses as a result of this unprecedented disaster; and 9 WHEREAS, in addition to the extreme personal loss these citizens experienced 10 through the complete destruction of their homes and businesses, they are also being 11 presented with severe water and gas bills as a result of these services running unabated for great lengths of time; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Public Service Commission is charged with ensuring a 14 regulatory balance that enables utilities to provide customers with safe, adequate and reliable services, at rates that are just, reasonable, equitable and economically efficient; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Public Service Commission has jurisdiction over publicly 17 owned utilities providing electric, water, waste water, natural gas, and telecommunications services; and 18

WHEREAS, in addition to regulation provided by the Louisiana Public Service

Commission relative to water and gas services, the commission is also in a unique position
to harmoniously interact with other regulatory agencies and local municipalities which also
provide oversight and enforcement in these areas; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide relief to the citizens of the state of Louisiana who

WHEREAS, in order to provide relief to the citizens of the state of Louisiana who have suffered such loss and devastation, rules and regulations should be promulgated to reduce the impact of these severe water and gas utility bills.
