1 A RESOLUTION

2 To adopt House Rule 10.10 of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives, to  
3 provide relative to indications of a vote of a member by the voting machine.

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana  
5 that House Rule 10.10 of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives is hereby  
6 adopted to read as follows:

7 Rule 10.10. Voting machine

8 The voting machine shall be set up for operation in a manner which prevents  
9 any other person from having an indication of the vote a member has cast until the  
10 vote is recorded and the voting machine is closed.
