

Proposed legislation provides a definition for "water-damaged vehicle" and "certificate of destruction".

Proposed legislation adds certificate of destruction to the disclosure of transfer of ownership in vehicles with salvaged or reconstructed titles in present law. Legislation sets application requirements, restriction on sale, disassembly requirements, department rules, and penalties in cases involving a certificate of destruction.

Proposed legislation provides that anyone who violates this provision shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for not more than 6 months.

Effective upon signature by the governor.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The Department of Public Safety notes that proposed legislation will require 80 hours of overtime for data processing at a rate of \$32 an hour to modify transactions and create a "Certificate of Destruction" form (80 hours * \$32/hour = \$2,560).

Public Safety indicates the overtime will be paid utilizing existing resources.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state governmental revenues as a result of this measure.

Persons found guilty of violating any provision of this legislation are subject to criminal penalties. The fine would be not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000. To the extent that this would occur, revenue to local governmental entities would increase.
