EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Election expenses for a statewide election are projected to be \$3,119,707. Since a provision in this bill limits the number of commissioners in certain precincts, the agency anticipates a \$396,500 savings in the regularly budgeted election expenses. In addition to the election expenses, \$125,000 for ballot printing and precinct supplies is also required. This would be the cost of holding a statewide election regardless of when the election would be held.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.


