HB No. 27

Abstract: Provides for a special statewide election on April 29, 2006, for the purpose of submitting constitutional amendments to the electors of the state.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a special statewide election to be held on the fifth Saturday in April of 2006 (April 29, 2006) for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the state any proposed constitutional amendments proposed by the legislature in accordance with law for submission on such date.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the special statewide election shall be held in compliance with and subject to the applicable provisions of <u>present law</u> (the Louisiana Election Code), except <u>proposed law</u> specifies that, for each precinct for such statewide special election in which no other election is being conducted, there shall be no more than two commissioners and a commissioner-in-charge selected by the parish board of election supervisors in accordance with <u>present law</u>.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
