FUNDS/FUNDING: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the appropriation of additional amounts in the Budget Stabilization Fund following the declaration of a state disaster or emergency (Item #19)

2	Proposing to amend Article VII, Section 10.3(C)(3) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative
3	to the Budget Stabilization Fund; to provide for appropriations from the fund
4	following certain declarations of disaster or emergency; to provide for an effective
5	date; to provide for submission of the proposed amendment to the electors; and to

7	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
8	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
9	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to
10	amend Article VII, Section 10.3(C)(3) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
11	§10.3. Budget Stabilization Fund

14	(C) The money in the fund shall not be available for appropriation or use
15	except under the following conditions:

17	(3) In no event shall the amount included in the official forecast for the next

five percent of the fund balance shall be available for appropriation by the legislature in any fiscal year to provide relief from a natural catastrophe declared by the federal government to be a disaster or emergency or to provide for matching funds for federal disaster or emergency funding for such catastrophe. The amount appropriated shall be incorporated into the official forecast upon the consent of two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature, such consent being provided in writing, in a manner established by law, if the legislature is not in session.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on April 29, 2006.

Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted to vote FOR or AGAINST, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution to the contrary, authorizes appropriation of up to seventy-five percent of monies in the Budget Stabilization Fund by the legislature in any fiscal year to provide relief from a natural catastrophe declared by the federal government to be a disaster or emergency or to provide for matching funds for federal disaster or emergency funding for such catastrophe. The amount appropriated shall be incorporated into the official forecast upon the consent of two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature, such consent being provided in writing, in a manner established by law, if the legislature is not in session. (Amends Article VII, Section 10.3(C)(3))

Alario HB No. 146

Abstract: Authorizes appropriation of up to 75% of the Budget Stabilization Fund to address a deficit following the declaration of a state disaster or emergency.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides for the establishment of a Budget Stabilization Fund, the deposits into the fund, and appropriations from the fund in certain circumstances related to revenue shortfalls.

<u>Present constitution</u> limits appropriations from the fund to one-third of the fund balance, which may be appropriated after two-thirds vote of both houses of the legislature.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> retains <u>present constitution</u> and provides that notwithstanding any other provision of <u>present constitution</u> to the contrary, authorizes appropriation of up to 75% of the balance of monies in the Budget Stabilization Fund to be available by the legislature in any fiscal year to provide relief from a natural catastrophe declared by the federal government to be a disaster or emergency or to provide for matching funds for federal disaster or emergency funding for such catastrophe. The amount appropriated shall be incorporated into the official forecast upon the consent of two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature, such consent being provided in writing, in a manner established by law, if the legislature is not in session.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held April 29, 2006.
