Provides with respect to the Louisiana Geographic Information System (Item #26)

The proposed legislation adds representatives to the Geographic Information System Council including the Department of Labor, DSS, and the Department of Education. Authorizes representatives on the council to appoint designees. Also establishes specific powers and duties for the La. Geographic Information Center (LAGIC), including entering into contracts and agreements, seeking reimbursements for certain activities, and seeking funding sources.
