## 1 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 1</u>

- 2 On page 2, deletes line 18 through 25 and insert
- 3 "hurricane protection inspection program. Such program shall include the following:
- 4 (1) Reviewing of hurricane protection diagrams, designs and plans.
- 5 (2) Monitoring of defects and problems.
- 6 (3) Conducting of an inspection of every hurricane protection barrier and associated
- 7 <u>elements at least every five years, or after a hurricane impacts a hurricane protection</u>
- 8 <u>barrier and associated elements. If a defect or problem is identified, then the authority</u>
- 9 shall measure and test elevations, soil conditions, and structural integrity of the
- 10 <u>hurricane protection barrier and associated elements.</u>"
- 11 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 2</u>
- 12 On page 2, line 26, change "(**C**)" to "(**B**)"
- 13 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- On page 2, line 27, after "<u>inspection</u>" insert "<u>results</u>"
- 15 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 4</u>
- On page 2, line 28, after "defect" insert a period and delete the remainder of the line
- 17 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 5</u>
- On page 2, line 29, delete "the remedy to correct the defect."
- 19 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>
- 20 On page 3, at the end of line 1, insert "The appropriate entity, or political subdivision,
- 21 <u>shall have fourteen days from receipt of the notice of defect to provide the authority</u>
- 22 with a plan to remedy the defect."
