SCR No. 18

Requests the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line to allow displaced Louisiana citizens to receive information related to the election process, including but not limited to voting rights and polling place locations, and to implement a national public service advertising campaign, pro bono if possible, to create public awareness of the toll-free telephone line.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to the original bill.

1. Changes the resolution from one that directs the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line for displaced La. citizens to be advised of their voting rights to one that urges and requests the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line to inform such citizens about the election process and to implement a national public advertising campaign to create public awareness of the toll-free telephone line.
2. Specifies that the implementation of the national public advertising campaign be pro bono if possible.
3. Changes references to "voting place" and "voting polls" to "polling place".
