Shepherd

Requests the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line to allow displaced Louisiana citizens to receive information related to the election process, including but not limited to voting rights and polling place locations, and to implement a national public service advertising campaign, pro bono if possible, to create public awareness of the toll-free telephone line.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and Governmental</u> <u>Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

- 1. Changes the resolution from one that directs the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line for displaced La. citizens to be advised of their voting rights to one that urges and requests the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line to inform such citizens about the election process and to implement a national public advertising campaign to create public awareness of the toll-free telephone line.
- 2. Specifies that the implementation of the national public advertising campaign be pro bono if possible.
- 3. Changes references to "voting place" and "voting polls" to "polling place".
