Subject: Coastal and Hurricane Protection Inspection

Page 1 of 1

Requires the wetlands authority to implement an inspection program for coastal and hurricane protection.

Proposed law defines "hurricane protection" as a system of barriers and associated elements to provide protection against tidal surges. Present law provides for the powers and duties of the Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Authority, including the development of a comprehensive conservation and restoration plan. Proposed law requires the Authority to establish and implement a comprehensive hurricane protection inspection program that will review hurricane protection diagrams, designs, and plans; monitor defects and problems; and measure and test the elevations, soil conditions, and structural integrity of the hurricane protection. Requires inspections to occur at least every five years and after a hurricane impacts a hurricane barrier and its associated elements. Requires the Authority to report a notice of defect to the appropriate entity, or political subdivision within two days of inspection.
