Within 24 fifteen days of receipt, the secretary and the clerk shall transmit to the Board of Ethics copies of all disclosure reports filed with them, respectively. Reports 25 26 transmitted by the secretary of the Senate and the clerk of the House shall be 27 deemed to having been filed with the Board of Ethics by the member, as of the date of filing with the clerical officer." 28
