AN ACT

2	To provide for an extended period of time for renewal or extension of oyster leases expiring
3	on January 1, 2006; to provide relative to terms of lease renewals or extensions; to
4	provide for the 2006 due date for annual rent for oyster leases; and to provide for the
5	2006 dates for determination and advertisement of defaulted oyster leases; to
6	suspend Section 501(G)(3) of Chapter 5 of Part VII of Title 76 of the Louisiana
7	Administrative Code relative to public auction of leases in default; and to provide
8	for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of R.S. 56:428, 428.1, 428.2, and 428.3
11	to the contrary, for any oyster lease for which the lease term ends January 1, 2006, and
12	which is eligible for renewal or extension, the secretary of the Department of Wildlife and
13	Fisheries has until May 1, 2006, to execute a renewal or extension. Such renewal or
14	extension shall be for a term not to exceed fifteen years, and the term shall be specified in
15	the lease renewal or extension. If a lessee has been notified by the Department of Wildlife
16	and Fisheries that the lease may be renewed or extended but the lease renewal or extension
17	is not executed by the secretary on or before May 1, 2006, the lease shall automatically be
18	renewed or extended for the period of time provided in the renewal or extension. The term
19	of a renewal or extension shall begin on the first day following the expiration date of the
20	prior lease. All other provisions of R.S. 56:428, 428.1, 428.2, and 428.3 shall be applicable
21	and enforceable in the same manner as those provisions have been applicable and
22	enforceable prior to the effective date of this Act.
23	Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of R.S. 56:429 to the contrary, each oyster
24	lease tenant shall have until March 31, 2006, to pay the required calender year 2006 annual

rental payment to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. Failure to pay the 2006 required rent punctually on or before March 31, 2006, ipso facto and without demand or putting in default, terminates and cancels the lease and forfeits to the department all the works, improvements, betterments, and oysters on the leased water bottoms. All other provisions of R.S. 56:429 shall be applicable and enforceable in the same manner as those provisions have been applicable and enforceable prior to the effective date of this Act. In addition, for the year 2006 only, the dates outlined in Section 501(G) of Chapter 5 of Part VII of Title 76 of the Louisiana Administrative Code shall be as follows: (G)(1), the list of leases in default shall be compiled no later than April 3, 2006; (G)(2), the advertisement of leases in default shall be submitted no later than April 17, 2006, for publication on the first available date thereafter, and reinstatement payments shall be received no later than July 1, 2006.

Section 3. Section 501(G)(3) of Chapter 5 of Part VII of Title 76 of the Louisiana Administrative Code is hereby suspended until December 31, 2006.

Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
