26 issued in accordance with R.S. 29:724, to relocate such facility

1           outside of the geographic area for which the original facility need  
2           review approval was granted.

3           (b) To permit a nursing home which has relocated, as the  
4           result of an executive order or declaration of emergency or disaster  
5           issued in accordance with R.S. 29:724, to obviate the provisions of  
6           R.S. 40:2116(D)(2).

7           Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the  
8           governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for  
9           bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article  
10          III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor  
11          and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective  
12          on the day following such approval."
