## **KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS IT LEFT THE SENATE**

SECRETARY OF STATE. Directs the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line for displaced citizens to advise them of voting locations and to advertise nationally seeking displaced Louisiana voters.

## SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and</u> <u>Governmental Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

- 1. Changes the resolution <u>from</u> one that directs the secretary of state <u>to</u> one which urges and requests.
- 2. Urges the secretary to implement a national public advertising campaign, "probono if possible," to create public awareness of the toll-free telephone line.

## DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS IT LEFT THE SENATE

Directs the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line and to advertise nationally to allow displaced Louisiana citizens to receive information related to the election process, including but not limited to, locating their polling place.
