Provides with respect to deadlines and requirements for the FY 2006-2007 budget (Item #24)

The proposed legislation suspends present law relating to the submission of budget requests by state agencies, as well as the submission of the executive budget by the governor for the purposes of the FY 06-07 budget. The commissioner of administration would be authorized to establish a due date for submission of budget requests which is later than November 15th and the governor would be required to submit the executive budget to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee no later than 21 days prior to the 2006 Regular Session of the Legislature. A written copy of the supporting documents must be submitted to the JLCB no later than seven days following the submission of the executive budget.
