| 10 | Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the secretary of the Department of |
| 11 | Transportation and Development, with approval of the House and Senate |
| 12 | Transportation, Highways and Public Works Committees, may utilize the design- |
| 13 | build method on any transportation infrastructure project in an area impacted by a |
| 14 | hurricane, including those areas where infrastructure is adversely impacted by |
| 15 | increased population and traffic as a result of a hurricane. In selecting a design-build |
| 16 | entity for any project authorized by this Section, the department shall comply with |
| 17 | the provisions of R.S. 48:250.3. |

| 1 | Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not |

| 2 | signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature |
| 3 | by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If |
| 4 | vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become |
| 5 | effective on the day following such approval. |
