**SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Senator Mount to Re-Reengrossed House Bill No. 1 by Representative Tucker

1    AMENDMENT NO. 1

2    On page 1, line 3 delete "and 1124.3," and insert ", 1124.3 and 1124.4,"

3    AMENDMENT NO. 2

4    On page 3, between lines 9 and 10 insert the following:

5           "D. If a gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster is in effect for an area which  
6           includes a candidate's domicile upon the last day in which a candidate is required to  
7           file a financial disclosure statement, the filing deadline shall be extended for a period  
8           of thirty days from the day the gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster  
9           terminates. However, the extension of the filing deadline shall not exceed a period  
10          of one hundred twenty days from the last day in which a candidate would normally  
11          be required to file a financial disclosure statement had there not been a  
12          gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster."

13   AMENDMENT NO. 3

14   On page 17, between lines 19 and 20 insert the following:

15          "§1124.4 Extension of Filing Deadline; Gubernatorially Declared Disaster  
16          If a gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster is in effect for an area  
17          which includes a person's domicile, who is required to file a financial disclosure  
18          statement pursuant to R.S. 42:1124, 1124.2, and 1124.3, upon the last day in which  
19          such person is required to file a financial disclosure statement, the filing deadline  
20          shall be extended for a period of thirty days from the day the gubernatorially  
21          declared emergency or disaster terminates. However, the extension of the filing  
22          deadline shall not exceed a period of one hundred twenty days from the last day in  
23          which such person would normally be required to file a financial disclosure  
24          statement had there not been a gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster."
