AN ACT

2	To enact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 893(E)(3), relative to the drug court division
3	probation program; to provide for the dismissal of prosecutions upon successful
4	completion; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 893(E)(3) is hereby enacted to read
7	as follows:
8	Art. 893. Suspension and deferral of sentence and probation in felony cases
9	* * *

12	(3)(a) When a case is accepted into a drug court division probation program
13	pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 13:5304 and at the conclusion of the probationary
14	period the court finds that the defendant has successfully completed all conditions
15	of probation, the court with the concurrence of the district attorney may set aside the
16	conviction and dismiss prosecution, whether the defendant's sentence was suspended
17	under Paragraph A of this Article or deferred under Subparagraph (1) of this
18	Paragraph. The dismissal of prosecution shall have the same effect as an acquittal,
19	except that the conviction may be considered as a first offense and provide the basis
20	for subsequent prosecution of the party as a multiple offender, and shall be
21	considered as a first offense for purposes of any other law or laws relating to
22	cumulation of offenses.

1 (b) The court may extend the provisions of this Paragraph to any person who 2 has previously successfully completed a drug court program and satisfactorily 3 completed all other conditions of probation. 4 (c) Dismissal under this Paragraph shall have the same effect as an acquittal for purposes of expungement under the provisions of R.S. 44:9 and may occur only 5 6 once with respect to any person. 7 8 Section 2.
