9 enact R.S. 45:844.43(21) and (22) and 844.45(C) is hereby amended and reenacted and"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, between lines 1 and 2, insert the following:

12 **§844.43. Definitions**

13 **As used in this Chapter, the following terms and phrases shall have the**  
14 **meanings hereinafter ascribed to them:**

15 **(1) "Advanced service" means high-speed Internet access capability in**  
16 **excess of ~~144~~ 512 kilobits per second both upstream and downstream.**  
17 **"Advanced services" shall include both cable and wireless Internet services.**

19 **(21) "Wireless Internet network" means high-speed Internet access**  
20 **capability allowing both upstream and downstream data by use of wireless**  
21 **Internet technologies.**

22 **(22) "Wireless Internet services" means high-speed Internet access**  
23 **capability allowing both upstream and downstream data by use of wireless**  
24 **Internet technologies.**

26 **§844.45. Scope of Chapter**

27 \* \* \*

28 **C. This Chapter shall not apply to any local government operating**  
29 **under a gubernatorially declared state of emergency that provides wireless**  
30 **Internet services via wireless Internet network when such services are provided:**

31 **(1) Free of charge to persons within the boundaries of the local**  
32 **government's jurisdiction; and**

33 **(2) Without commercial advertising or other charges to view or access**  
34 **the Internet; and**

35 **(3) For no longer than one year following the date the gubernatorially**  
36 **declared state of emergency is lifted.**
