AUCTIONS/AUCTIONEERS: Repeals the continuing education requirement for auctioneers

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 37:3112(B)(2) and 3115.1, relative to continuing education of auctioneers;
3 to repeal the requirement that licensed auctioneers take six hours of continuing
4 education annually.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 37:3112(B)(2) and 3115.1 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Abstract: Repeals the six-hour continuing education requirement for licensed auctioneers.

Present law requires each individual licensed auctioneer in the state of La. to take six hours of continuing education courses annually relating to the business of auctioneering in order to maintain eligibility for renewal.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Present law provides that the Auctioneer Licensing Board prescribe and adopt regulations, standards, procedures, and policies governing the manner and conditions under which credit is given by the board for the continuing education requirement.

Proposed law repeals present law.
