SENATE BILL NO. 68

MALPRACTICE. Increase per diem payable to the attorney chairman of a medical malpractice review panel.

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1299.47(I)(1)(b), relative to medical
3 malpractice; to provide for an increase in the per diem payable to the
4 attorney chairman of a medical malpractice review panel; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:1299.47(I)(1)(b) is hereby amended and reenacted
8 to read as follows:

9 §1299.47. Medical review panel

10 * * *

11 I.(1)(a) * * *

12 (b) The attorney chairman of the medical review panel shall be
13 paid at the rate of ~~one hundred~~ **two hundred** dollars per diem, not to
14 exceed a total of ~~two~~ **three** thousand dollars for all work performed as
15 a member of the panel exclusive of time involved if called as a witness
16 to testify in a court of law regarding the communications, findings, and

1 conclusions made in the course and scope of duties as a member of the
 2 medical review panel, and in addition thereto, reasonable travel
 3 expenses. Additionally, the attorney chairman shall be reimbursed for
 4 all reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incurred in performing his duties
 5 for each medical review panel. The attorney chairman shall submit the
 6 amount due him for all work performed as a member of the panel by
 7 affidavit, which shall attest that he has performed in the capacity of
 8 chairman of the medical review panel and that he was personally
 9 present at all the panel's meetings or deliberations.

DIGEST

Proposed law increases the per diem rate of the attorney chairman for services on a medical review panel from \$100 to \$200 and the maximum allowable compensation for all work performed from \$2,000 to \$3,000.
