2	To amend and reenact Children's Code Article 793.1(introductory paragraph), 793.2
3	(introductory paragraph), and 793.3 (A), (B)(introductory paragraph), and (D) and
4	to repeal Children's Code Article 793.3(E), relative to reauthorization of the early
5	intervention program for at-risk children; to make the program permanent; to
6	eliminate a sunset date for the program; to provide for an effective date; and to
7	provide for related matters.
8	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
9	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
10	Louisiana.
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
12	Section 1. Children's Code Article 793.1(introductory paragraph), 793.2
13	(introductory paragraph), and 793.3 (A), (B)(introductory paragraph), and (D) are hereby
14	amended and reenacted to read as follows:
15	Art. 793.1. Early intervention pilot program; authorization; purpose
16	The purpose of this Article and Articles 793.2 through 793.4 is to authorize
17	the creation of an early intervention pilot program, hereinafter referred to as the
18	"pilot program", in the parishes of Iberia, St. Mary, and St. Martin which shall serve
19	as pilot sites. The purpose of the program shall be to address the underlying causes
20	of behavioral problems and school performance problems related to behavior by
21	pooling existing resources targeted at the child and family through appropriate action
22	by service and treatment providers. The legislature finds:

## 1 Art. 793.2. Community involvement 2 In the event that the pilot program is created, duly Duly authorized 3 representatives of the local school board, law enforcement agencies, including 4 sheriffs' offices and city and municipal police offices, courts exercising jurisdiction 5 over juveniles and their caretakers, and designated service providers shall sign 6 interagency agreements specific to each parish representing a commitment by each 7 entity to agree to provide the following types of services: 8 9 Art. 793.3. Reporting; funding; implementation; termination 10 A. No later than June fifteenth of each year, the district attorney shall report 11 statistical data indicating the effectiveness of the pilot program to the appropriate 12 standing committees of the legislature for use by the committees in consideration of 13 the continuation or expansion of the program. 14 B. The pilot program shall be implemented in three phases as follows: 15 16 D. The implementation of this <del>pilot</del> program may be subject to appropriation 17 of funds by the legislature for such purpose. 18 19 Section 2. Children's Code Article 793.3(E) is repealed in its entirety. 20 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 21 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 22 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
