Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Engrossed House Bill No. 745

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 3, at the end of line 3, after "beginning." delete "The" and delete lines 4 through 6  
3 in their entirety

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 3, delete lines 11 through 24 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

6 "A. The legislature hereby recognizes that the East Baton Rouge  
7 Parish School Board and the Central Community School Board entered into  
8 a Quitclaim, Transfer and Conveyance Deed and Waiver, Release, and  
9 Indemnity Agreement effective June 25, 2009, and filed and recorded in East  
10 Baton Rouge Parish Original: 167, Bundle: 12186, by which the East Baton  
11 Rouge Parish School Board, to the extent allowed by law, transferred,  
12 conveyed, assigned, quitclaimed, released and relinquished to the Central  
13 Community School Board any rights, title and interests, including but not  
14 limited to mineral rights and rights of management, administration,  
15 custodianship, control, and maintenance, that the East Baton Rouge Parish  
16 School Board had or may have had in under, and to that portion of sixteenth  
17 section land, Township 5 South, Range 2 East, through which Louisiana  
18 Highway 64 runs, in East Baton Rouge Parish commonly referred to as the  
19 "Indian Mound Tract".

20 B. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the state of  
21 Louisiana hereby acknowledges, consents to, approves, ratifies and confirms  
22 the Quitclaim, Transfer and Conveyance Deed and Waiver, Release, and  
23 Indemnity Agreement filed and recorded in East Baton Rouge Parish  
24 Original: 167, Bundle: 12186. The state of Louisiana hereby further  
25 transfers, conveys, and assigns to the Central Community School Board all  
26 of its ownership rights, title and interest, including mineral rights, operation,  
27 management, administration, custodianship, and control of the property  
28 described in Subsection A of this Section subject to any servitudes, building  
29 restrictions, rights of way, mineral servitudes or leases, or any other matters,  
30 established by law or of record in the records of East Baton Rouge Parish.

31 C. The state of Louisiana hereby acknowledges and confirms that the  
32 Central Community School Board is and shall be entitled to all income  
33 derived from the Indian Mound Tract including but not limited to mineral  
34 rights and all mineral income, except that portion to which the Livingston  
35 Parish School Board is entitled. To the extent necessary, the state of  
36 Louisiana transfers and assigns all right, title and interest in and to any and  
37 all existing leases including but not limited to mineral leases and mineral  
38 contracts related to the Indian Mound Tract."
