

## HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 745 by Representative White

SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS: Provides relative to the transfer of certain 16th section lands from EBR Parish School System to Central Community School System and authorizes Vermilion Parish School Board to sell certain 16th section lands

### Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Deletes proposed law providing that EBR Parish School Board shall transfer to Central Community School board all ownership rights (including mineral rights), operation, management, and control of the 16th section land known as the "Indian Mound Tract" and authorizing the school boards to enter into agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute documents necessary to properly effectuate the delivery of complete title to such property.  
  
Provides instead for legislative recognition of legal documents executed relative to the transfer of the specified 16th section lands from the East Baton Rouge Parish School Board and the Central Community School Board and confirms that the Central Community School Board is entitled to income derived from the specified lands. Further provides for transfer of the state's interest in existing leases related to the specified lands.
2. Makes additional changes to geographic boundaries between EBR Parish School System and Central Community School System.
3. Authorizes the Vermilion Parish School Board to sell certain specified 16th section lands.

### Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law establishes a separate school system for the Central community in East Baton Rouge Parish. Proposed law provides for legislative recognition of legal documents executed relative to the transfer of specified 16th section lands (commonly known as "Indian Mound Tract") from the East Baton Rouge Parish School Board to the Central Community School Board; provides for state acknowledgment and confirmation that the Central Community School Board is entitled to income derived from Indian Mound Tract; provides for transfer of the state's right, title, and interest in existing leases related to Indian Mound Tract; and makes changes to the geographical boundaries between the two school systems.

Proposed law additionally authorizes the Vermilion Parish School Board to convey, transfer, assign, and deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state or the school board may have to certain 16th section lands as described in proposed law.

Effective in part upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
