**Abstract:** Provides relative to the disbursement of funds for loss of life opportunities of persons who were wrongfully convicted, requiring proof of enrollment or registration or proof of actual expenses incurred.

Present law provides for the disbursement of funds up to \$80,000 for the loss of life opportunities of persons who were wrongfully convicted in order to pay for certain job-skills training, education, or other medical and counseling services.

Proposed law retains present law but requires the petitioner to show that he has enrolled in or has registered for such training, classes, or services, or provide proof of actual expenses incurred as a result thereof.
