The source of monies for the fund shall be 28 appropriations, donations, grants, and other monies which may become available for 29 30 the purposes of the fund. Any judgment rendered pursuant to this Section shall be 31 payable only from the fund established herein. No state agency, political 32 subdivision, constitutional office, nor employee thereof shall be liable for any
- payment ordered pursuant to this Section.

12	Innocence Compensation Fund as authorized by this Section.
