COURTS/MAYORS: Authorizes an increase in court costs in the mayor's court for the town of Mansura

1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 33:447.11, relative to the mayor's court of the town of Mansura; to authorize 3 an increase in court costs for violations of municipal ordinances; and to provide for 4 related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 33:447.11 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 7 §447.11. Mayor's court; town of Mansura; additional court costs 8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the mayor of the 9 town of Mansura, may impose court costs not to exceed eighty-five dollars for each 10 offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant convicted of a violation of a 11 municipal ordinance. The court costs authorized by this Section shall be in addition 12 to the court costs authorized by R.S. 33:441.

Johnson HB No. 295

Abstract: Authorizes an increase of \$85 in court costs for violations of municipal ordinances in the Mayor's Court of the town of Mansura.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 33:441) authorizes a mayor, as the presiding officer of a mayor's court, to impose court costs, not to exceed \$30 for each offense, on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the mayor for the town of Mansura to impose additional court costs not to exceed \$85 for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.
