Abstract: Requires the assessor's notice to the taxpayer to include the current year and previous year's property tax assessment and property value and to clearly indicate the change in the property's value.

<u>Present law</u> requires assessors to provide notice to a taxpayer of the amount of the assessment of the taxpayer's property, including supplemental assessments, in any tax year in which property is reappraised and valued pursuant to <u>present constitution</u> and when the taxable assessment of the taxpayer's property for a tax year increases by 15% or more from its assessment in the previous tax year.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds that the notice shall include the taxpayer's property tax assessment and property value for the current year and the property tax assessment and property value for the previous year. Additionally requires Louisiana Assessor's Association to design the notice which shall be uniform throughout the state and which shall be an appropriate size so as to clearly indicate to the taxpayer the change in the property's value.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
