The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Jerry J. Guillot.

## DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the transport of hazardous materials on La. Highway 73 between Interstate 10 and La. Highway 74 and within 300 hundred yards or less of any building used as a public or private elementary or secondary school, except for carriers making local deliveries on this portion of La. Highway 73.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and also prohibits the transport of hazardous materials on that portion of La. Highway 48 designated as Apple Street in Norco.

<u>Present law</u> provides that whoever violates <u>present law</u> shall be fined not more than \$200, or imprisoned for not more than 90 days, or both. Provides that on a second or subsequent violation the offender shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$500, or imprisoned for not less than 10 days nor more than six months, or both. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2013.
