**Subject:** Notification to Taxpayer of Property Assessments

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TAX/AD VALOREM TAX OR NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to information included in certain taxpayer notifications from assessors

**Purpose of Bill:** This measure provides that the assessor's notice shall also include the taxpayer's property tax assessment and property value for the current year and the property tax assessment and property value for the previous year. Currently, the local assessor is required to provide notice to taxpayers of the amount of their property assessment for tax years in which property is reappraised and when the taxable assessment increases by 15% or more from its assessment in the previous tax year.

The measure also requires the Louisiana Assessor's Association to design the notice which shall be uniform throughout the state and which shall be an appropriate size so as to clearly indicate to the taxpayer the change in the property's value.
