HCR No. 29

Requests that the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) study the feasibility and advisability of requiring training for teachers and other school employees relative to armed intruders on school campuses and submit a written report of findings and recommendations to the House and Senate education committees at least 60 days before the 2014 R.S. Provides that the study and report shall include, at a minimum, consideration of costs relative to requiring the training, who might provide the training, how the requirement would be enforced, and what measures, if any, are being taken by other states with respect to requiring such training.
