Except as otherwise provided by this Section and 19 beginning with the 2007-2008 school year through the 2012-2013 school year, meets standards for admission to the desired college or university and has successfully 20 completed at least seventeen and one-half units of high school course work as 21 22 permitted by this Subparagraph, which constitutes a core curriculum."
