Proposed legislation includes a definition of authorized other charges positions to mean the number of positions in an appropriation bill to be funded by the other charges continuing category of the accounting system of the state. Proposed legislation provides that personnel tables for each department shall also include authorized other charges positions in the Executive Budget and the Executive Budget Supporting Document.
