Prohibit smoking on the grounds of and inside the facilities or buildings utilized by the institutions managed and supervised by certain post secondary education management boards. (gov sig)

Present law provides the general smoking prohibitions and exemptions. Proposed law provides an additional prohibition to include no smoking on the grounds of or inside the facilities or buildings utilized by institutions managed and supervised by the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System. Effective upon governor's signature.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation may increase SGF expenditures to purchase no smoking signs as required under current law (R. S. 40:1300.261). However, campuses report that such costs should be minor, and campuses can notify affected persons in other ways (emails, websites, policy manuals, etc). The Southern System already prohibits smoking on all campus grounds.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Current law (R. S. 40:1300.262) authorizes fines related to violations of the proposed legislation. There is no way to estimate potential fines that might be collected. Collection of such fines may offset costs to implement the proposed legislation.
