HB No. 207

Abstract: Authorizes each public postsecondary education management board to name buildings at institutions under its supervision and management in honor of living persons.

Present law provides that no public building, public bridge, public park, public fish or game preserve, or public wildlife refuge owned by the state or by any political subdivision of the state or by any institution receiving its support in whole or in part from the state shall be named in honor of any living person, except as authorized or provided by law.

Present law provides generally for the powers, duties, and functions of public postsecondary education management boards. Proposed law authorizes each board to name buildings at institutions under its supervision and management in honor of living persons pursuant to a policy adopted by the board. Provides that such policy may include criteria to be used for the naming of buildings in honor of living persons.
