Heitmeier (SB 35)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the Department of Health and Hospitals shall submit a diabetes action plan, after consulting with and receiving comments from the medical director of each of the contracted Medicaid partners, to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare and the House Committee on Health and Welfare no later than February first of each year.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the Department of Health and Hospitals shall submit an obesity action plan, after consulting with and receiving comments from the medical director of each of the contracted Medicaid partners, to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare and the House Committee on Health and Welfare no later than February first of each year.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the action plan shall contain the financial impact and reach that obesity is having on the state of Louisiana and its residents.
