1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 12, delete "prescription" and insert in lieu thereof "peremption"

9 "Sanctions for refusal to timely pay a required assessment shall include the sanctions
10 enumerated in R.S. 22:13 or R.S. 22:16, at the discretion of the commissioner."

12 On page 4, line 27, after "board" insert "or liquidator"

21 "A. Any action against the plan, the board, the employees of the plan, or any
22 combination thereof, shall be subject to a preemptive period ending on December 31,
23 2014, at which time the right to assert a cause of action shall be extinguished."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 10

25 On page 6, delete lines 3 through 9 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

26 "Section 2. R.S. 22:1209 and 1210 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

27 Section 3. Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on December 31, 2014.

1 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without
3 signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution
4 of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the
5 legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
