15 team merit a sincere measure of commendation for the pride and honor they have brought
16 to their school, the state of Louisiana, and the Shreveport community; and

17 WHEREAS, the members of the team credit their success to the support from alumni,
18 faculty, staff, and students of Louisiana State University at Shreveport.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
20 commend the Louisiana State University at Shreveport debate team upon its memorable and
21 historic success and national championship title at the 2013 International Public Debate
