- 16 "(1) Such information shall be posted prominently both inside and outside restrooms in the premises, and in any areas that are frequently used by employees of 17 the establishment including but not limited to dressing rooms and break rooms inside 18 19 the establishments described in subsection A of this Section. 20 (2) Such posting shall be no smaller than eight and one-half inches by eleven inches and shall contain the following wording in bold typed print of not less than 21 22 fourteen-point font: 23 "If you or someone you know is being forced to engage in any activity and cannot leave, whether it is commercial sex, housework, farm work, or any other activity, call the 24 25 National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline at 1-888-373-7888 to access help and 26 services and any other requirement established by regulations promulgated by the commissioner in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act. 27 28 The victims of human trafficking are protected under U.S. law and the laws 29 of Louisiana. 30 The hotline consists of the following services: 31 (a) Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. 32 (b) Toll-free. 33 (c) Operated by a non-profit, non-governmental organization. 34 (d) Anonymous and confidential. 35 (e) Accessible in 170 languages. (f) Able to provide help, referral to services, training, and general 36 information". 37
