18	(4) The assistant secretary of the office of public health of the
19	Department of Health and Hospitals shall appoint one of its two appointees to
20	the committee to serve as chairman of the committee. The chairman shall call
21	the first meeting no later than September 1, 2013. The committee shall meet
22	monthly until the requirements of Paragraph (D)(9) of this Section are
23	complete. Thereafter, the committee shall meet quarterly. Additional meetings
24	may be called by the chairman. The chairman shall call additional meetings if
25	requested in writing by at least nine committee members.
26	(5) Nine members of the committee physically present shall constitute a
27	quorum and the presence of a quorum shall be required to transact the business
28	of the committee.
29	(6) The meetings of the committee shall be subject to the Louisiana Open
30	Meetings Law.
31	(7) The meetings of the committee shall be held at the Department of
32	Health and Hospitals headquarters in Baton Rouge.
33	(8) The office of public health of the Department of Health and Hospitals
34	shall provide administrative assistance to and serve as staff for the committee.
35	(9) The rules and regulations for the Louisiana Standards for Water
36	Works Construction, Operation, and Maintenance shall not be promulgated
37	until the proposed rules and regulations or changes thereto are approved by the
38	Department of Health and Hospitals and approved by a majority vote of the
39	committee.
40	E. No provision of this Section shall prohibit the Department of Health
41	and Hospitals from promulgating rules pursuant to the Administrative
42	Procedure Act to secure or maintain from the United States Environmental
43	Protection Agency primacy in drinking water regulation provided such rules
44	shall be limited to only those rules required to secure or maintain such
45	primacy."
