(f) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in the event the 13 14 fund is dissolved or liquidated, any remaining balance after all amounts due 15 under this Part to medical malpractice claimants, including future medical care and related benefits as provided in R.S. 40:1299.43, and all amounts due any 16 17 other person for administrative or operating expenses have been paid from the fund, shall be paid over to the state general fund by the board or then 18 administrator of the fund for deposit in the state treasury. 19 20 \* \*

Section 3. The provisions of Section 2 of this Act shall be given retroactive
