Proposed law requires public post secondary education institutions to develop smoke-free policies for its campuses and defines "smoke-free" to be the prohibition of smoking in present law. Proposed law does not prohibit a public post secondary education institution from developing a tobacco-free policy at its campus. Defines "tobacco-free" to mean the prohibition on the use of tobacco derived or containing products, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, cigarillos, pipes, hookahsmoked products, and oral tobacco products. Proposed law does not supersede the general smoking prohibitions in present law. Effective on August 1, 2014.
