SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Provides relative to the parcel fee collected by the  
Lakeview Crime Prevention District.

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:9091(F)(2), relative to the parcel fee levied by  
3 the Lakeview Crime Prevention District; to provide relative to the levy  
4 of the fee on condominiums; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 33:9091(F)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read  
7 as follows:

8 §9091. Lakeview Crime Prevention District

9 \* \* \*

10 F. Parcel fee. The governing authority of the city of New  
11 Orleans is hereby authorized to impose and collect a parcel fee within  
12 the district subject to and in accordance with the provisions of this  
13 Subsection:

14 \* \* \*

15 (2)**(a)** The fee shall be imposed on each improved parcel located  
16 within the district.



Present law provides that the parcel owner is responsible for payment of the fee.

Proposed law retains present law and provides that with respect to condominiums, the condominium association of unit owners shall be responsible for the fee.

Provisions of proposed law apply to any taxable period beginning after December 31, 2000.

1. Clarifies that with respect to condominiums, the condominium association of unit owners shall be responsible for the fee.
