Increases the continuing education requirements from six to twelve hours of approved instruction for title insurance

producers. (8/1/13)

<u>Present law</u> requires title insurance producers to complete six hours of approved instruction prior to license renewal. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that with renewals effective beginning in 2015, twelve hours of approved instruction or verifiable self-study must be completed prior to license renewal with at least two of those hours dedicated to matters related to state and federal consumer finance protection laws.
