KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

COURTS. Authorizes courts exercising juvenile jurisdiction to designate by rule one or more divisions to which gun and weapon-related offenses may be assigned and to establish a weapon-related offenses probation program. (gov sig)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Clarifies that program be an intensive probation program.
- 2. Provides that the program be under the direction of the office of juvenile justice.
- 3. Removes authority to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement with the district attorney, local public defender, office of juvenile justice, or any public or private agency to implement proposed law.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that each court exercising juvenile jurisdiction may by local rule designate as a gun division one or more divisions to which gun and weapon-related offenses are assigned and may establish an intensive probation program to be administered by the presiding judge or judges thereof or by an employee designated by the court under the direction of the office of juvenile justice.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
