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Provides with respect to workers' compensation

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "payor" as the entity responsible for payment of benefits by a claimant as a result of a work related injury and requires the employer or payor to prepare a "Notice of Modification, Suspension, Termination, or Controversion of Compensation and/or Medical Benefits". <u>Proposed law</u> requires the employer/payor to send a copy of the first payment of compensation to the Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC)/Office of Worker's Compensation within 10 days of the date of the original notice was sent to the injured employee. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that if an injured employee disagrees with any information on the notice form, he shall notify the employer/payor by returning the form, or by letter of amicable demand, and provide any amounts of compensation he believes appropriate. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the employer/payor shall not be subject to any penalties or attorney fees. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the employer/payor does not provide the benefits that the employee may file a disputed claim for benefits.
