<u>Prior law</u> prohibited the transport of hazardous materials on La. Highway 73 between Interstate 10 and La. Highway 74 and within 300 yards or less of any building used as a public or private elementary or secondary school, except for carriers making local deliveries on this portion of La. Highway 73.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and also prohibits the transport of hazardous materials on that portion of La. Highway 48 designated as Apple Street in Norco, except for carriers making local pickups or deliveries, carriers using the route to reach a local pickup or delivery point, or carriers using the route to reach maintenance or service facilities.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that whoever violates <u>prior law</u> shall be fined not more than \$200, or imprisoned for not more than 90 days, or both. Provided that on a second or subsequent violation the offender shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$500, or imprisoned for not less than 10 days nor more than six months, or both. <u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u>.
