Peacock (SB 23)

<u>Prior law</u>, relative to dealers of motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles, defined the term "community or territory" or "area of responsibility".

<u>New law</u> removes from the definition of "community or territory" or "area of responsibility" the requirement that the area of responsibility for a motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle dealership be an area within at least a 30-mile radius of the location of his dealership.

<u>Prior law</u> required the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission (commission) to notify existing licensed motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle dealership or dealerships selling the same-line makes, models, or classifications if a new dealership or relocation of an existing dealership is within the existing dealer's area of responsibility.

<u>New law</u> changes criteria to determine which existing dealership or dealerships the commission must notify if a new dealership or if an existing dealership relocates in a particular area. The new criteria will be based on a 30-mile radius of the proposed new dealership or the proposed relocation address of a dealership.

Effective August 1, 2013.
