2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1730.26(2), 1730.28(A)(3)(a)(introductory paragraph) and
3	(e), and 1730.29 and to enact R.S. 40:1730.28(A)(3)(h), relative to the state uniform
4	construction code; to require the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code to
5	review, evaluate, and update the state uniform construction code; to adopt Part V-
6	Mechanical of the International Residential Code; to provide for plumbing and
7	sanitary references in Part V-Mechanical of the International Residential Code; to
8	provide for the regulation of certain construction or improvement of industrial
9	facilities; and to provide for related matters.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 40:1730.26(2), 1730.28(A)(3)(a)(introductory paragraph) and (e),
12	and 1730.29 are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 40:1730.28(A)(3)(h) is hereby
13	enacted to read as follows:
14	§1730.26. Adoption and promulgation of certain building codes and standards as
15	state uniform construction code; procedures
16	The council shall review, adopt, modify, and promulgate the building codes
17	referenced in R.S. 40:1730.28 of this Part, provided that:
18	* * *
19	(2) The council shall review, evaluate, and update the state uniform
20	construction code prior to the second regular legislative session after the release of
21	the latest edition no later than five years from the date of publication of the
22	appropriate code as provided for in R.S. 40:1730.28. The council shall submit the
23	updated state uniform construction code to the House Committee on Commerce and
24	the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs

2	each house of the legislature a summary of the major proposed changes to the
3	International Residential Code at the time of submission to the oversight committees.

5	§1730.28. Mandatory adoption of certain nationally recognized codes and standards
6	as the state uniform construction code; adoption by reference
7	A. Except as provided in Subsection C of this Section, the council shall
8	evaluate, adopt, and amend only the latest editions of the following as the state
9	uniform construction code:
10	* * *
11	(3)(a) International Residential Code, not including Parts I-Administrative,
12	V-Mechanical, VII-Plumbing and VIII-Electrical. The applicable standards
13	referenced in that code are included for regulation of construction within this state.
14	The enforcement of such standards shall be mandatory only with respect to new
15	construction, reconstruction, additions to homes previously built to the International
16	Residential Code, and extensive alterations; however, a municipality, parish, or
17	regional planning commission may enforce Appendix J of the code at its option. The
18	appendices of that code may be adopted as needed, but the specific appendix or
19	appendices must be referenced by name or letter designation at the time of adoption,
20	with the exception of Appendix J, Existing Buildings and Structures, which shall not
21	be adopted by the council and may be adopted and enforced only at the option of a
22	parish, municipality, or regional planning commission. For the purposes of this Part,
23	IRC R301.2.1.1 (Design Criteria) shall be amended as follows and shall only apply
24	apply only to the International Residential Code, 2003 edition:

26	(e) Part IV-Energy Conservation of the latest 2009 edition of the
27	International Residential Code is hereby shall be adopted and is amended to require
